## **Generac Foundation Giving Guidelines and Eligibility**

## **Eligible Organizations:**

- We will primarily contribute to organizations based in our Generac communities or that provide direct services in a geography that includes one of our manufacturing facilities or offices, and align to our giving priorities.
- To be eligible for funding, an organization must be IRS certified as 501(c)(3) nonprofit in the United States or equivalent.
- Organizations must operate in full accordance with non-discriminatory practices, offering their programs or services to all.

## In general, the Generac Foundation does <u>not</u> consider or support:

- Individual person(s), family memorials or fundraisers that are for specific individuals or personal expenses, including for the benefit of a Generac employee.
- Religious organizations or places of worship, or other organizations primarily promoting religious purposes, or congregation-only programs.
- Political, labor, and fraternal organizations.
- Family Foundations or other privately held Foundations that are not considered a public charity.
- Funding for individuals to attend a conference, mission trip or similar event. In addition, we do not provide funding for travel expenses.
- Organizations that do not comply with the USA Patriot Act (or other applicable anti-terrorism rules/laws).
- Multi-year commitments are not made.
- Tuition scholarships.
- Third-party fundraisers.
- Capital campaigns will not be supported.
- Endowments including endowed chairs at educational institutions or non-profit endowment campaigns.
- Generac Foundation does not make donations of Generac products nor provide grants to enable the purchase of a Generac product.

Since we receive requests that exceed our available resources, we must often decline support to worthy organizations and programs. Such a response does not reflect, in any way, a negative appraisal of the prospective organization or the value of its programs and services.

All funding decisions are final and at the discretion of Generac and the Generac Foundation. Guidelines are subject to change without notice.
